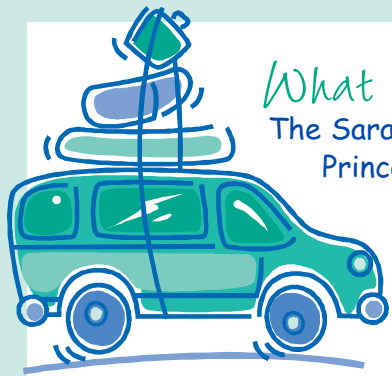

## What Is the Sarah Petit Fund?

The Sarah Petit Fund, administered and supported by The Arc of Prince George's County, provides supplemental grants to assist persons with developmental disabilities to participate in a wide variety of recreational and travel experiences. The Fund was established in memory of Sarah Ellen Petit (1974-2002), a young woman with developmental disabilities whose love for recreation and travel, and whose joy in sharing these with family and friends, inspired its creation. The Fund's hope is that these experiences will foster the growth of friendships, meaningful community relationships, and joy in living for as many people in as many different life situations as possible.

## Who Is Eligible for Grants from the Fund?

The Sarah Petit Fund is open to persons of all ages with developmental disabilities who are ongoing participants in programs and services of The Arc of Prince George's County, or who are members or dependents of members of The Arc.

## How Are Grants Awarded from the Fund?

The Sarah Petit Fund Committee, composed of three volunteers and two Arc staff members, reviews all grant applications and determines whether to approve requests based on information given in the applications.

## How Does the Committee Select Grant Recipients?

The Committee evaluates the ways that the supported activity will help the applicant to build friendships, strengthen links to the community, and enrich quality of life. The Committee also considers the financial reasonableness of the request and whether the applicant has previously received a grant.

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## How Much Can the Fund Help Me with Recreation and Travel Expenses?

Grants are typically awarded in amounts up to \$400. The Committee will consider reasonable requests for larger grants, depending on the nature of the activity and the availability of funds.

## When Should I Apply?

Although exceptions may be made for an applicant's special circumstances, the Committee strongly recommends submission of applications at least six weeks before the date that the funds are required, to allow adequate time for review and processing by the Committee and by The Arc's business office.

## Can I Make A Donation to the Sarah Petit Fund?

Yes! Donations are always welcomed and deeply appreciated, to help grow the fund and spread the fun. Checks should be made out to The Arc of Prince George's County, with the Sarah Petit Fund noted on the memo line. You can also support the Sarah Petit Fund by participating in or donating to The Arc's annual Bowling Bash, proceeds of which are designated exclusively for the Fund.
